QuickSearch can generate references for you. Follow these easy steps to build your reference list.

1. Enter your keywords into QuickSearch.
2. Click on the “double quote” icon to the right of the entry.



Remember to check citations for accuracy before including them in your work

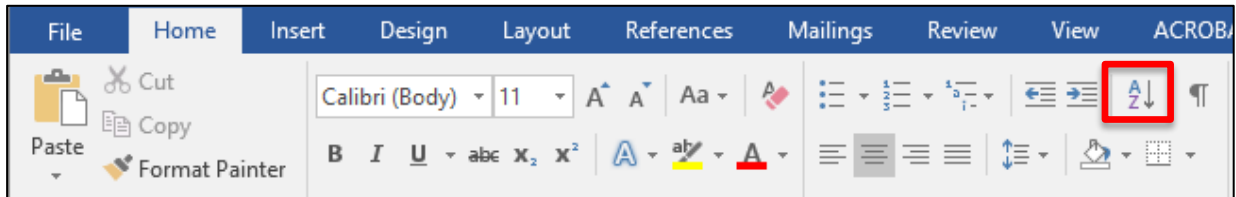
For example, this reference has the article title all in CAPITAL letters, because the original article has the title in CAPITAL letters.

QuickSearch can only format the information as is provided by the source, so check FedCite, at <https://federation.edu.au/library/student-resources/fedcite> for the correct format.

Hot tips for formatting your Word document reference list.

Use the in-built features in Word to save yourself time when formatting your references.

1. Use the **'Sort'** function to **alphabetise** your reference list.
Select all of your references, and then click on the Sort button.



2. Use **CTRL-T** hot keys to go from this ...
