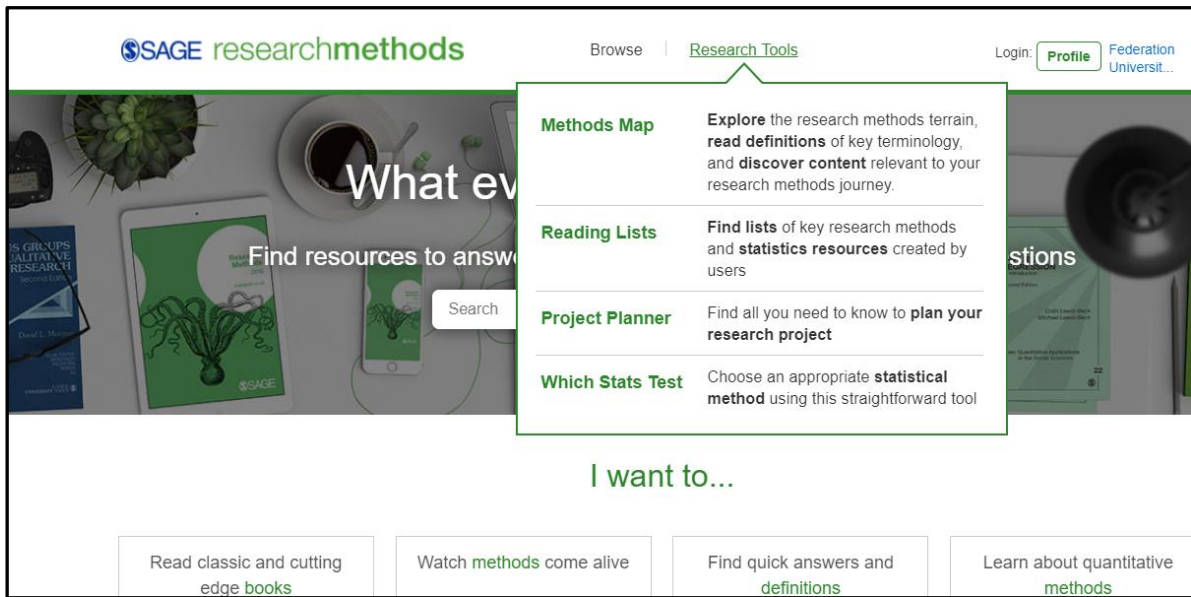

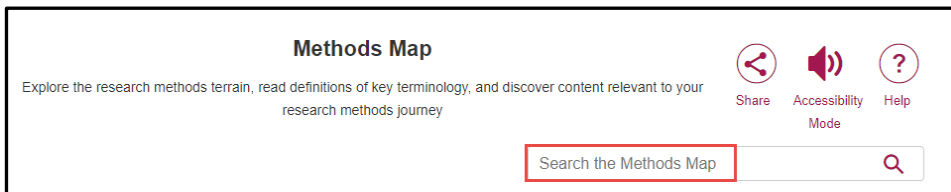

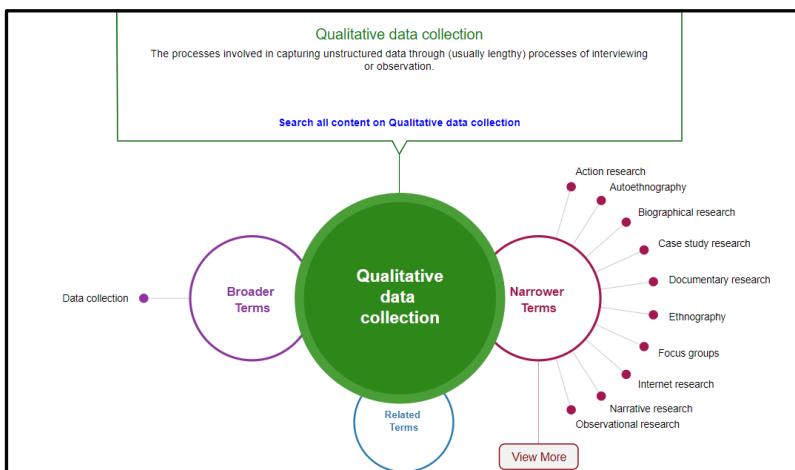


Methods maps




